pursuant to the directions of the Act of Congress of the United States, entitled  
"An Act to Establish an Uniform Rule of Naturalization, etc.," passed April  
14, 1802, and the Acts subsequently passed on that subject, and to the directions  
of the Act of Congress entitled "An Act to Regulate the Immigration of Aliens  
into the United States," approved March 3, 1903, and said applicant having  
appeared personally in Court, producing such evidence and affidavits and making  
such declarations and renunciations, and taking such oaths as are by the said Acts  
required. And all of said papers being filed and recorded,

Thereupon, It was ordered by the Court, that the said applicant be admitted,  
and he was accordingly admitted to be **A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.**
