

BULLET MISSES BABE.

Wife Wounded When Husband Fires "Unloaded" Revolver.

Mrs. Gladys Showalter, 20 years old, 523 Baum street, was shot accidentally yesterday by her husband, John Showalter, 20 years old, when she was asleep at their home. The bullet passed through her lung and lodged in a chair on the opposite side of the room. Showalter told police that he un-

loaded the revolver Sunday night and placed it on the dresser. Believing the weapon to be empty when he arose yesterday morning, he picked it up and pulled the trigger. Mrs. Showalter corroborated her husband's story that the shooting was an accident.

Mrs. Showalter was attended by Dr. M. A. Zett, Covington, Ky. Her wound is not serious. The bullet narrowly missed the couple's eighteen-months-old babe, lying in bed beside the mother.
